



# Receive Books From First Book

**First Book** provides new books to children in need addressing one of the most important factors affecting literacy - access to books. First Book provides books through **three different methods**:

## First Book Advisory Boards

First Book Advisory Boards are an extensive network of volunteer community leaders serving as ambassadors dedicated to fundraising, community outreach and raising awareness of literacy issues within local communities. These Boards raise funds locally and grant books to qualified programs in their communities. A typical book grant is for one year, offering each child in the program a steady supply of books (usually one book per month) at no cost to the child or the recipient organization.

## First Book Marketplace

The First Book Marketplace is an online store selling high-quality children's books and educational materials at deeply discounted prices to organizations serving children from low-income families. The Marketplace offers a broad range of high quality and award-winning titles for children ages 0-18, including board books, picture books, novels, reference books and bilingual titles. The average price for a Marketplace title is less than \$1.85, including shipping and handling.\*

## First Book National Book Bank

The First Book National Book Bank is a centralized distribution system for large-scale donations of children's books from publishers to programs serving children in need. Book distributions are hosted throughout the year at a variety of sites nationwide. The books are free to organizations that can pick them up on site or cost just \$0.25 per book to have them shipped. There is no set schedule or list of upcoming locations for book distributions. Due to high demand, organizations should apply online for the books they are interested in as applications become available; books are allocated on a first come first served basis.
